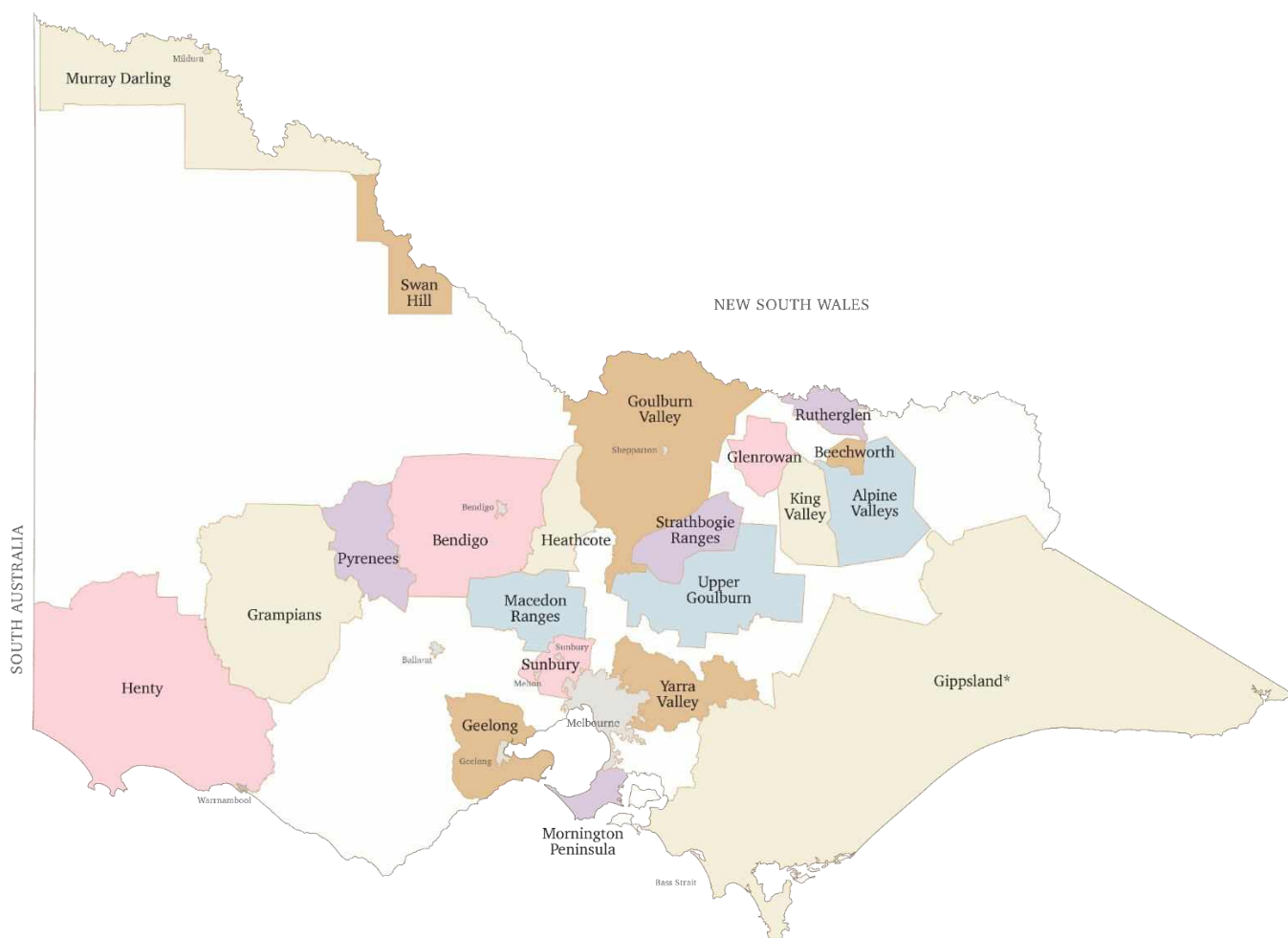

THE WINE REGIONS OF VICTORIA



Victoria's status as the state with the largest total area devoted to wine regions truly sets it apart.

Unlike other states where wine regions might be limited to specific areas, in Victoria, you're never far from a vineyard—often within an hour or two's drive. This proximity to diverse wine regions enriches Melbourne's dining and wine culture, making it a hub for wine enthusiasts and culinary exploration.

The state's extensive network of wine regions, spanning from the cool climate zones of the Yarra Valley and Mornington Peninsula to the warmer areas like Heathcote and even the Murray Darling provides a rich tapestry of flavors and styles. This accessibility and diversity contribute significantly to Melbourne's reputation for vibrant food and wine experiences.

With its diverse landscapes and climates, Victoria offers a complex and varied wine profile that's difficult to pin down to a single style. The state's vineyards range from cool climate regions that excel in Chardonnay and Pinot Noir to warmer areas that produce standout Grenache, Mourvèdre, and Southern Italian varieties like Aglianico and Vermentino. This range of conditions and grape varieties speaks to Victoria's commitment to regionality.

In fact, Victoria's dedication to exploring and showcasing its regional differences is more pronounced than in other states. Take the Mornington Peninsula, for example—a smaller GI with a significant length from north to south. This variation allows for the development of unofficial subregions, which are often as distinct in their characteristics as those found in more famous wine regions like Burgundy, where the distance from Aloxe-Corton to Santenay is comparable. This nuanced approach to regionality within Victoria highlights the state's dedication to capturing and celebrating the unique terroirs of each area, contributing to the rich and varied wine culture of Victoria.

A VICTORIAN LEGEND – MOUNT MARY



Mount Mary stands as one of Australia’s finest boutique wineries since its founding by Dr. John Middleton in 1971. With the first plantings completed by mid-1972, the estate now spans 40 acres under vine, nurturing 18 grape varieties. Renowned for both the distinct character and unparalleled quality of its wines, the winery has cultivated a near-mythical reputation, commanding the admiration of collectors worldwide.

Nestled on a north-facing slope, the vineyard captures the full benefit of sunlight throughout the growing season, ensuring a purity of fruit that is the hallmark of Mount Mary’s wines. The ‘*Quintet*’, a masterful blend of Bordeaux varietals, stands as the epitome of the estate’s ethos—its exceptional poise, structure, and vibrancy speak to the unique terroir and to Dr. John Middleton’s meticulous respect for the land.

While Mount Mary has evolved, it has always remained deeply faithful to the vision of its founder. Today, his son David carries forward the legacy, overseeing the business, while grandson Sam has stepped into the role of winemaker with skill and passion, ensuring the continued excellence of this iconic estate.

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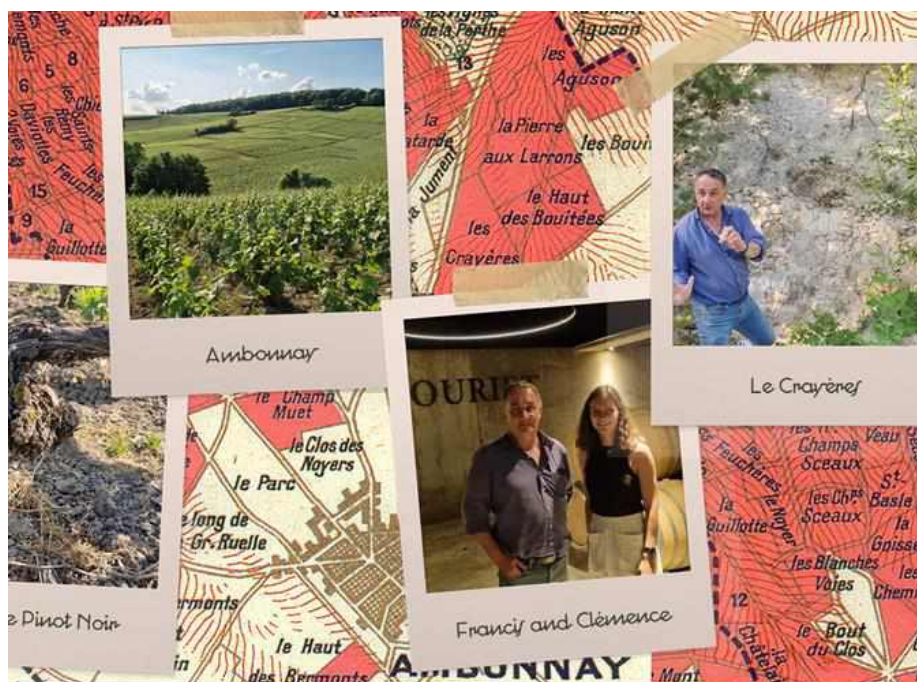

Sites like Wehlener Sonnenuhr, Graacher Himmelreich, and others have centuries of winemaking history, which contributes to a profound sense of place and heritage in their wines. The unique terroir of these sites, characterized by their steep slopes, slate soils, and microclimates, imparting distinctive minerality and depth. In addition, 90% of J.J. Prüm's estate vines are ungrafted and have an average age exceeding 60 years, with some parcels aged between 70 and 100+ years, has significant implications for their quality, being more concentrated in flavor and character.

What sets them apart is their unwavering commitment to stainless steel, eschewing barrels even for their esteemed Premier Crus and Grand Crus, thus preserving the unadulterated character of their vineyards. Their dedication to perfection is further evidenced by their selective late harvesting, ensuring each glass reveals the full spectrum of chardonnay fruit flavors.

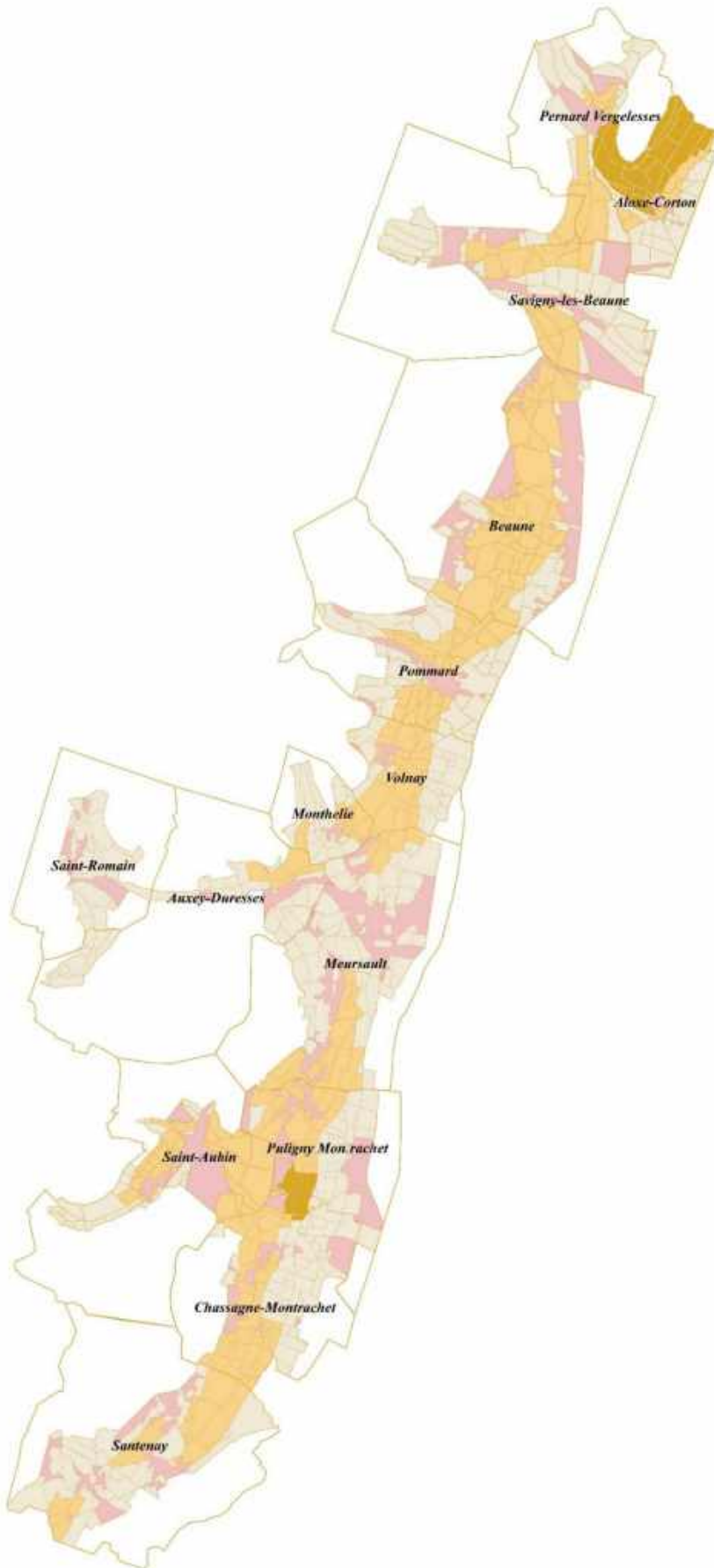

THE HOME OF CHARDONNAY – CÔTE DE BEAUNE



Côte de Beaune, the southern part of Burgundy's Côte d'Or, is renowned primarily for its exceptional white wines, particularly the legendary Montrachet vineyard. While the region does produce notable red wines, it is best known for its white, which are often considered some of the finest chardonnays in the world.

As you travel south from the Pinot Noir-rich villages of Savigny-lès-Beaune, Pommard, and Volnay, you'll discover a cluster of villages renowned for their Chardonnay. Monthelie, Saint-Romain, Auxey-Duresses, Meursault, Puligny-Montrachet, Saint-Aubin, and Chassagne-Montrachet are synonymous with the height of white Burgundy, crafting cuvées that are both lush in fruit and perfectly structured. The region's distinctive terroir and careful winemaking practices enhance the complexity, balancing rich fruit flavors with mineral undertones.

Their layered complexity often improves with age, allowing the wines to develop further nuances and depth over time. Whether enjoyed young or after extended aging, these wines exemplify the elegance and sophistication of Burgundian whites, offering a quintessential expression of Chardonnay.

BURGUNDIAN STAR STILL ON THE RISE - PIERRE-YVES COLIN-MOREY



Pierre-Yves, the eldest son of the renowned Marc Colin and partner to Caroline Morey of the prestigious Morey family of Chassagne-Montrachet, requires little introduction given his illustrious lineage. Having worked at the family domaine from 1994 to 2005, he took his six hectares of vineyards and established his own label after harvesting the much celebrated 2005 vintage.

Since departing from the family domaine, Pierre-Yves has fine-tuned his winemaking practices. For example, he no longer employs *batonnage*, and the cellar is no longer heated to encourage malolactic fermentation. His wines now spend more time in oak—one-third of which is new, sourced from two cooperages, François Frères and Chassin. Except for his Saint-Aubins, all his wines are aged on lees for 18 months. The result is a range of wines that are fleshy and rich, yet retain a striking freshness on the palate.

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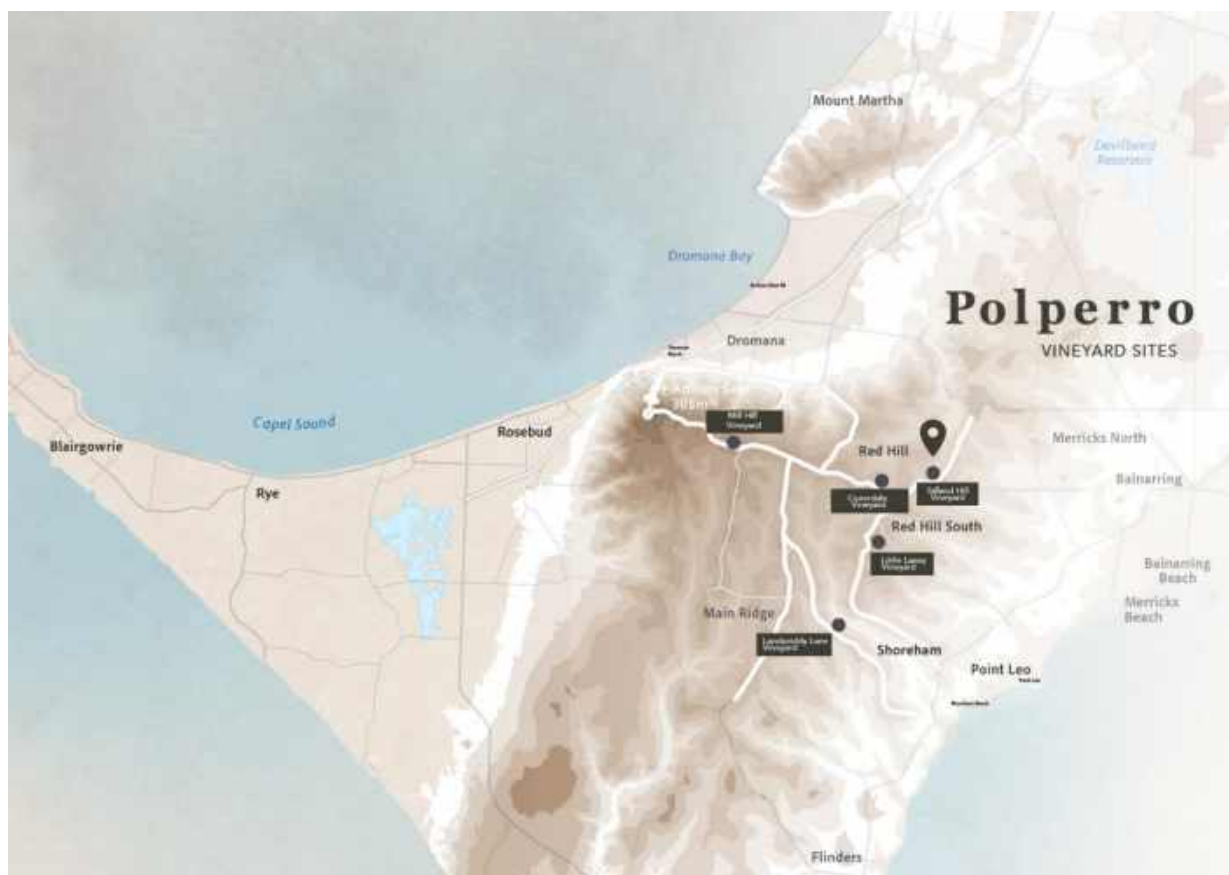

His time in France, particularly under the tutelage of Jean-Marc Lafage in the Rousillon region, left an indelible mark on his career.

In 2006, Sam took the plunge and launched his own label, Even Keel. With a focus on producing wines characterized by brightness and drinkability, Even Keel quickly gained recognition for its quality and approachability.

Building on the success of Even Keel, Polperro came in 2008. Highlighting premium single sites in Mornington, he emphasises the distinctiveness of the sub-regions through refined expressions of pinot noir and chardonnay.

EXCITING PINOT NOIR FROM AN EXRTREME CLIMATE – FELTON ROAD



Felton Road is a pioneering force in the Bannockburn sub-region of Central Otago, located in the southernmost part of the G.I. Their vineyards are among the most southerly planted in the world, a testament to the region’s unique and exceptional climate for growing Pinot Noir. Since their first vintage in 1997, Felton Road has garnered widespread acclaim, swiftly earning accolades such as “Stunning Debut,” “Best New Winery,” and “Pinot Noir of the Year,” firmly establishing their place among the world’s elite producers.

Spanning four vineyards, with exposures ranging from north to north-east and encompassing five distinct soil types, Felton Road has placed an unwavering focus on revealing the singularity of Bannockburn’s terroir. In recent years, the winery has embraced a philosophy of finesse over power, emphasizing elegance, tannin structure, and minerality rather than fruit extraction.

The Elms Vineyard Single Blocks produce wines with distinct character, shaped by the complex variation in terroir. The Cornish Point vineyard, at its lower elevation and influenced by the nearby lake’s moderating effect, offers wines of fragrant intensity with deep, darker flavors. In contrast, the Calvert Vineyard, bathed in abundant sunshine at a slightly higher elevation, yields wines with a firm tannin structure and expansive texture. The newly purchased MacMuir vineyard, planted at high density and with heavy silt soils, brings forth wines with complex fruit profiles, whilst still exhibiting a similar tannin structure and minerality to those of the nearby Calvert Vineyard.

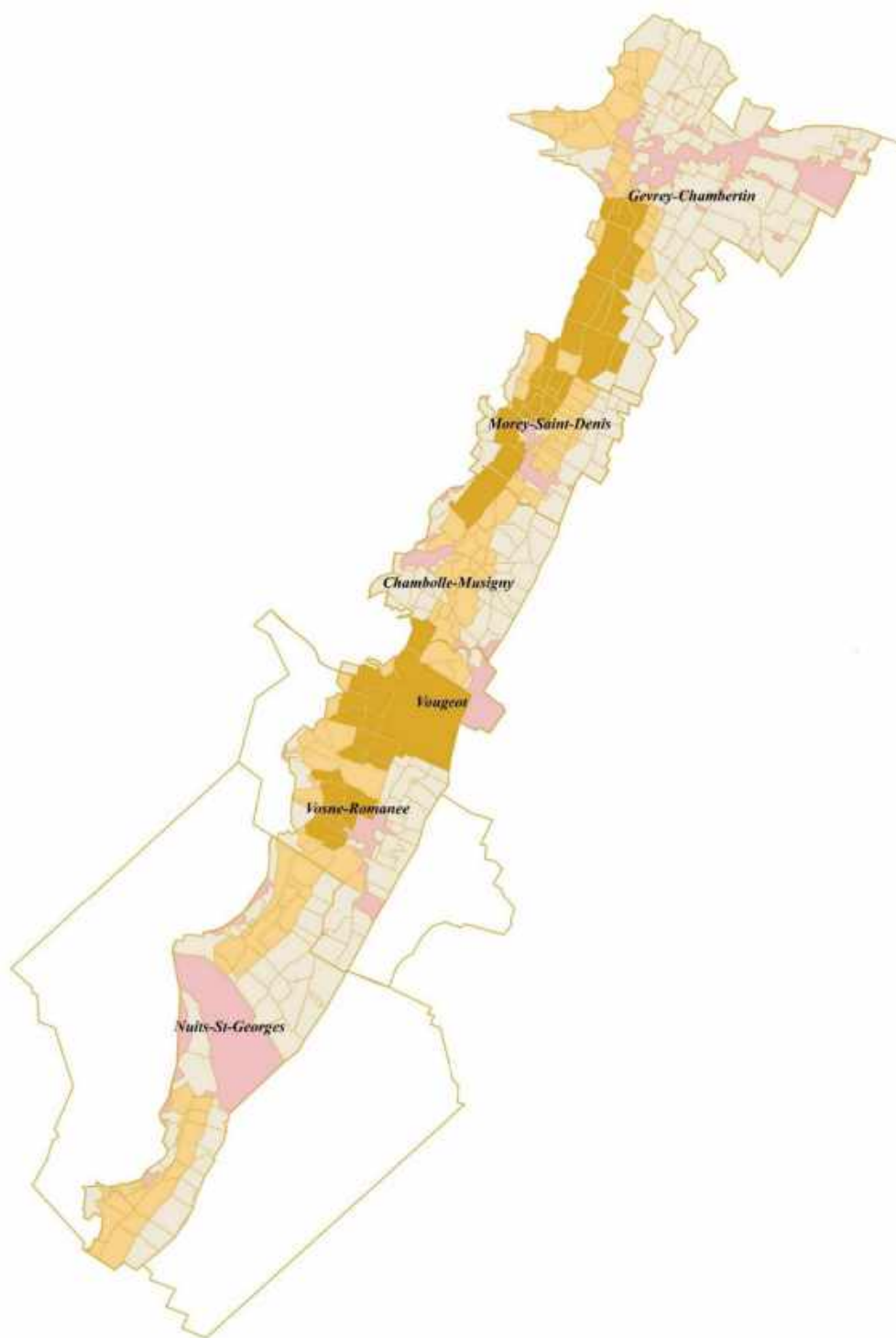

THE CRÈME DE LA CRÈME OF PINOT NOIR – THE TERROIRS OF CÔTE DE NUITS

The Côte de Nuits, located just south of Dijon in Burgundy, is renowned for producing some of the world's most celebrated red wines. This distinguished region stretches along the D974 highway, which links Dijon with Beaune, and is affectionately referred to as the Routes des Grand Crus due to the high concentration of prestigious vineyards along this route.

Indeed, out of the 33 Grand Cru vineyards in Burgundy, 24 are situated in Côte de Nuits, including one of the most unique and noteworthy Grand Cru vineyards; Musigny Grand Cru - the only Grand Cru vineyard in Burgundy that produces both red and white wines.

These Grand Cru sites are the epitome of quality in Burgundy, each offering unique expressions of the Pinot Noir grape. The region is remarkably small – 24km from North to South, yet its varied terroir allows for a range of styles, from the delicate and perfumed wines of Chambolle-Musigny to the robust and structured offerings from Gevrey-Chambertin.



NÉGOCIANT GENIUS - BENJAMIN LEROUX



Ben made a name for himself as the manager of Domaine du Comte Armand in Pommard, before launching his own négociant business in Beaune. His adventure quickly gained recognition, with wines that demonstrate remarkable consistency in challenging vintages and truly shine in exceptional ones. More recently, he has begun acquiring vineyards, now owning nearly one-third of his production. However, it was his talent for sourcing and crafting high-quality wines from small, select parcels that truly highlights his brilliance.

Although he is renowned for his white wines, especially his Bâtard-Montrachet Grand Cru, Ben's reds—given his history in the predominantly red-wine-producing commune of Pommard—are equally celebrated, known for their finesse and vibrant character.

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MODERN AUSTRALIAN COOL-CLIMATE SHIRAZ – SYRAHMI



Adam Foster's journey into winemaking is a tale of culinary curiosity evolving into a passion for crafting exceptional wines that express the essence of their terroir.

Initially trained in the culinary arts, Adam honed his skills in the kitchens of Australia and London. Despite his focus on the culinary world, he maintained a keen interest in wine, particularly the intricacies of cellar management and wine lists. It was a vintage experience at the esteemed Torbreck winery in the Barossa that captivated Adam, prompting him to transition from the culinary realm to the world of winemaking. Eschewing formal training, Adam embarked on an unconventional path, learning the craft through hands-on experience and mentorship. His journey led him to work alongside luminaries in the wine industry, including Stéphane Ogier, Michelton, Pierre Gaillard, Jasper Hill, and Chapoutier. These experiences provided Adam with invaluable insights and expertise, shaping his approach to winemaking.

The experience allowed him to establish Syrahmi in 2004 – derived from *Syrah* and French *ami* – ‘friend’. Initially all grapes were sourced - selecting grapes from a different vineyard each year, and naming the vintage accordingly. Syrahmi are always single clone, single vineyard wines, whereas Demi is a blend and made up of multiple clones and vineyards. La La is only made in exceptional vintages.

Adam's winemaking philosophy revolves around minimal intervention, allowing the true terroir of the vineyard and the nuances of each vintage to shine through. This approach emphasizes trust in nature's processes, resulting in wines that capture the essence of their origins. In 2017, Adam took a significant step forward by planting his own high-density vineyard in the south-east of Heathcote, further cementing his dedication to crafting wines that authentically reflect their place of origin.

TAPESTRY OF BLOCKS

The Hill of Grace Vineyard is divided into fourteen blocks. Six of these make up Hill of Grace Shiraz, each contributing unique characters. The oldest of these, 'The Grandfathers', were planted around 1860.

1. The Grandfathers Shiraz (ca. 1860, 0.56ha): Big berries, bright red fruits, floral, long velvety tannins, excellent balance, plenty of flesh and concentration.
2. Post Office Block 1 Shiraz (1910, 0.33ha): Blue fruits and supple Palate texture, exotic five-spice complexity, black pepper and fine velvety tannins.
3. House Block Shiraz (1951, 1.08ha): Small berries and intense concentration. Great depth, sage spice and black pepper; brooding, with a rich middle palate, darker fruits and a late display of firmer tannins.
4. Church Block Shiraz (1952, 0.7ha): Small berries on shallower soil; more spice, sage and pepper; long and svelte, great structure, plum-fruit flavour and velvety tannins. Windmill Block Shiraz (1956, 0.70ha): A vigorous section of the
5. Windmill Block Shiraz (1956, 0.57ha) A vigorous section of the vineyard, its fruit character more forward, showing leafy notes, red fruits, ripe herbs and pepper.
6. Post Office Block 2 Shiraz (1965, 0.57ha): Spicy, red fruits, black pepper and sage. The palate has red and blue fruits, star anise spice, fleshy structure and fine, velvety tannins

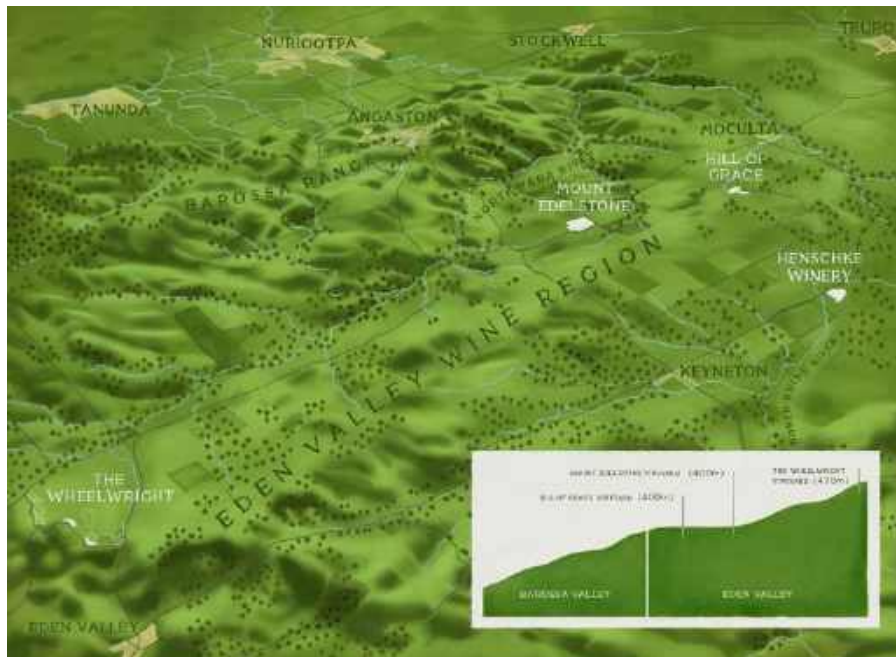

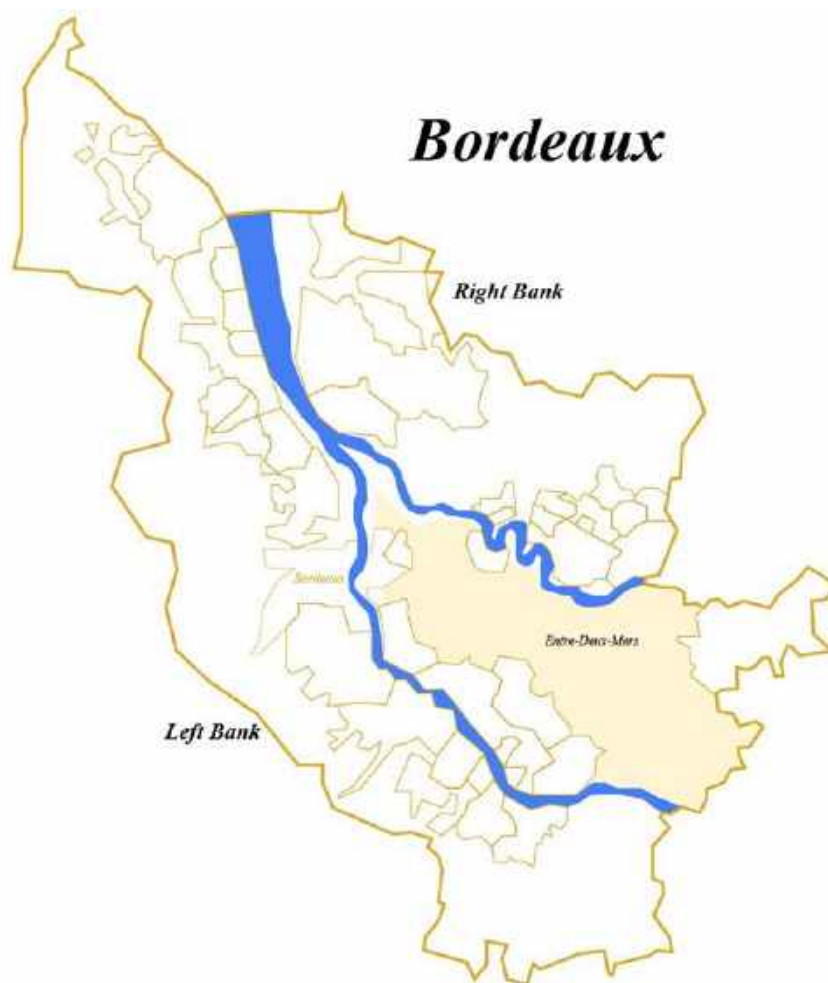

THE ART OF BLENDING - BORDEAUX



Bordeaux is the largest AOC (Appellation d'Origine Contrôlée) wine region in France. The region spans 213 kilometers from north to south and 105 kilometers from east to west, encompassing approximately 114,000 hectares of vineyards.

The Bordeaux region is shaped by two major rivers, the Garonne and the Dordogne, which converge to form the Gironde Estuary. This confluence creates an inverted Y shape that extends for 75 kilometers before flowing into the Atlantic Ocean.

Wines from the "Left Bank" originate from the area along the Garonne and Gironde rivers, on the side closest to the Atlantic Ocean. These wines are stereotypically dominated by Cabernet Sauvignon. In contrast, "Right Bank" wines come from the land situated on the right bank of the Dordogne River, where Merlot tends to be the dominant varietal.

The Bordeaux blend of grapes varies by estate, with each estate benefiting from its own unique microclimates and soil types. This diversity influences the choice of varieties planted, resulting in blends that either reflect the specific characteristics of the estate or adhere to the typicity of the appellation. Blending is a longstanding tradition in Bordeaux, largely due to the AOC regulations which require that all fruit must come from estate holdings. Unlike Burgundy, where wines from a single plot are common, Bordeaux estates typically feature a mix of different terroirs. In addition, the region's climate, heavily influenced by the Atlantic Ocean, can lead to significant vintage variation, as different grape varieties respond differently to each year's conditions.

Even within sub-regions, the diverse soil types mean that no single varietal is ideally suited to an entire appellation. For instance, within the Saint-Émilion AOC, wines can range from fragrant and mineral-driven to voluptuous and powerful, depending on factors such as soil composition and micro-climate (excluding winemaking choices).
